Producer Rajan Shahi who had brought a turn around in the TV industry with two shows Sapna Babul Ka Bidaai and Yeh Rista Kya Kehlata Hai on Star Plus is coming with two new shows named Amrit Manthan on Life Ok and Jamuna Paar on Imagine TV.

Rajan Shahi held first schedule of the show Jamuna Par in Delhi and personally chose the location of India Gate. We shot at night so there was less crowd and it is the first time I didn't bump into each other.
